



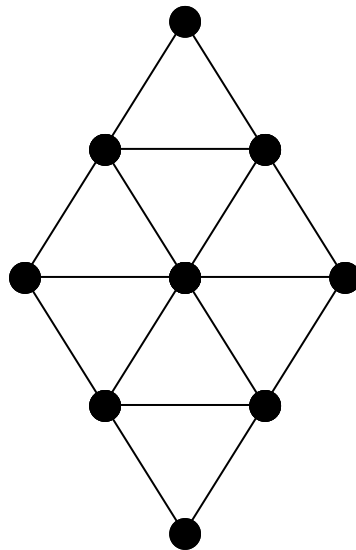
Neurological Nasties
